The Knox County Emergency Communications District (KCECD) E911 Center is scheduled for a virtual assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the assessment, agency employees and the public are invited to offer comments by calling (865) 215-1199 on November 1, 2021, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.
